Packham Harvesting provides professional contract harvesting services to properties across Central Queensland, New South Wales and Victoria.

The team travels to each property with a caravan to house them on site until the job is complete. This offers exceptional harvest oversight and a dedication to exceeding the customer's expectations.

Their equipment, advanced technology and offers maximum efficiency to ensure a high-quality product and output.

Their John Deere 8520 tractor is attached to a 25 tonne OzTec chaser bin. The bin has a 19" discharge auger and is capable of unloading 10 tonnes per minute. Having a chaser bin in the field allows the team to keep the headers moving at all times and ensures the harvest is completed quickly.

Wheat, barley, oats, canola (direct heading and/or pickup), chickpeas, faber beans, mung beans and sorghum.

SERVICING & MAINTENANCE

Packham Harvesting is committed to keeping its equipment in excellent condition to limit breakdowns, prioritise safety and ensure a smooth harvest.

Major services are performed on all machines prior to the harvest season and pre-start checks are completed daily and blow-down inspections conducted at the end of every shift.

A service truck equipped with welders, tools, fluids, parts and other items that may be needed is also available on site for every project.
